Term 1 - Pre-Nursing Assistant Classes

Sept 1 - Sept 25

- MTS students - period 3 & 4 in room 314
- Medical Terminology (.25 LA), Health Careers (.25 EL), Medical Math (.25 MAT), & Keyboarding (.25 EL)
- The last week of class will start Patient Feeding and CPR (both located in the same room and time)

Term 2 - Patient Feeding and CPR Classes

Sept 21 - Oct 14

- MTS students - period 3 & 4 in room 314
- Patient Feeding (Day B)
- CPR (Day A)
- 1 Cr HE

Term 3 - Patient Feeding Clinical

Oct 19 - Nov 5

- MTS students - periods 3 & 4 at Nursing Home
- This term requires the students to leave a little early from their 2nd hour class. This is required in order to be able to eat before the patients are fed
- Van leaves at 11:30 each day from the High School and students eat at the nursing home
- Other students may leave later after lunch at the High School - it will depend on the placement

Term 4 - Nursing Assistant Class

Nov 9 - Nov 24

- MTS students - All day at Comfort Services (2200 Minnehaha)

- Nursing Assistant lecture, quizzes, skills demonstrations, and skills checkoffs
- 1 Cr LA / 1 Cr SCI

Term 5 - Nursing Assistant Class & Clinicals

Nov 30 - Dec 18

- MTS students - All day at Comfort Services (2200 Minnehaha) or nursing home
- Nursing Assistant lecture, quizzes, skills demonstrations, and skills checkoffs
- Clinicals are one week long - either the week before or the week after winter break
- White shirt, white scrub shirt and pants, and white shoes required.
- 1 Cr SS / 1 Cr MAT

Term 6 - Home Health Aide & State Test

Jan 4 - Jan 21

- MTS students - All day at Comfort Services (2200 Minnehaha)
- Home Health Aide lecture, quizzes, and test
- Test preparation and review (both skills and knowledge)
- Nursing Assistant State Test
- 1 Cr Work Experience / 1 Cr HE
