



2022 Graduates and their Families of MTS:

Please review the information enclosed. Here is some important information.

- **In order to participate in the graduation ceremony, Seniors need to have completed at least 60 credits by the end of the school year.** The requirements to earn a diploma is to have 64.5 credits and also in the required content areas. If by looking at the graduation requirements, the number completed is not 60 (in the appropriate areas), they need to be in communication with Mr. Brady or Ms. Lane to create a plan to make up for some of the missing credits. If the Seniors are not completing their work and/or in communication with their teachers, it may jeopardize their graduation.
- **Graduation will be Saturday, June 11th and the ceremony will be at 10am at the Minneapolis Convention Center (MCC) Room 200.** Graduates will need to be at the MCC no later than 8:30am to practice the procession and closing ceremony. This is one of the most important days in their life and they will want to make sure they know what they are doing.
- **Caps and gowns have arrived!** Students do not need to purchase the cap or gown. We will provide them. If you wish to purchase these items to have as your own or decorate: Cap and gown is \$25.00, just the cap is \$5 (cash only). Otherwise, they can pay for any items on the day of graduation. We steam the gowns and bring them to the MCC on the day of the ceremony. We will give the '22 tassel to each graduate.
