Don Shelby is considered the most decorated local television anchor and reporter in the country. He has won three National Emmys, along with two George Foster Peabody awards and the National Distinguished Service Award from the Society of Professional Journalists. He was also inducted into the Broadcasting Hall of Fame. Since retirement, Don has stayed active as a writer and a reporter. He recently won another Emmy for his work with Bill Moyers on a special for PBS, and is nominated again this year for his PBS interview with Ken Burns.

He has 52 years of experience as a journalist, is an author, as well as a mountain, rock, and ice climber, lecturer, and explorer.

Academy as he also serves a part of Minneapolis College's Advisory Board for their Collegiate Recovery Community and Program, and is an advisor on the Coalition of Recovery Investments (CORI). He is the Vice Chairperson of the Association of Recovery Schools (ARS), and is a part of the ARS Executive Council.
