# Career and College Readiness: Notification of Public Education

Districts must assist students with career and college readiness. Minnesota Statutes, section 120B.30 requires a school or district to record student progress toward career and college readiness on the high school transcripts of students.

Students who do not meet or exceed the Minnesota Academic Standards, as measured by the MCA administered in high school, are to be informed that admission to a public school is free and available to any resident under 21 years of age until at least one of the following occurs: 1) The first September 1 after the student's 21<sup>st</sup> birthday; 2) The student's completion of academic and course credits for graduation requirements; 3) The student's withdrawal with no subsequent enrollment within 21 calendar days; or 4) The end of the school year
