

What Incoming Kindergartners Need to Know

The following are essential learnings and expectations for graduating summer school kindergartners, as identified by kindergarten teachers.

Math

- Identify what a number is
- Counting up to 10
- 4 basic shapes square, circle, rectangle, triangle
- Identify colors red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, white, black, gray, pink, brown

Reading

- Identify what a book is, how to hold a book and turn pages
- Sing ABCs
- Identify their names

Writing

- How to hold a pencil
- How to write their names on paper
- How to color
- Tracing with pencils, crayons and scissors

Science

- How to observe things what do you notice
- Mixing colors what happens

Social Studies

- What rules are and how to follow them
- What routines are and how to follow them

Basic Skills

- How to hold a pencil, a scissor and crayons, and how to use glue
- Respond to basic questions
- How to use the bathroom (bathroom routines such as flushing toilets and washing hands)
- How to wipe themselves (teacher must encourage parents to teach this to their child entering kindergarten)
