

MPS is providing FREE food for ALL children, 18 and under, during COVID-19 school closure. All families are welcome to participate in this program. Weekly food boxes are available for pick-up **Monday-Friday from 10-2**. We are at ten different sites per day, giving families fifty pick-up locations across Minneapolis to choose from throughout the week. **Look for the yellow school bus at all MPS food pickup sites!** To keep families and staff safe, we provide contact-free pick-up.

Each food box contains items for fourteen meals -- seven breakfasts and seven lunches. Families are welcome to take one box per child, per week. Many food items require refrigeration. Supplemental groceries are available for families in partnership with **The Sheridan Story** while supplies last.



Download Free Meals for Kids App

Free food for kids 18 and under is only a click away. Starting immediately Hunger Impact developed the Free Meals for Kids mobile app to help families and kids in need to find and access free food at sites across Minnesota. This free app shows food pick-up locations with days and hours of distribution and can help families find the sites nearest to them.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

How is this food program operated and funded?

MPS CWS is working hard to provide food at no cost for all children, 18 and under, during the COVID-19 school closure. We are able to provide this food through the Summer Meals Program which was established to ensure that children continue to receive nutritious meals when school is not in session. The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) administers this program and provides reimbursement to MPS CWS for the meals that we serve. All families are welcome to participate in this program.

Are there alternative options for children with food allergies?

MPS food boxes do NOT contain pork, peanuts, tree nuts, fish, or crustacean shellfish. If your child is allergic to milk, egg, soy, or wheat MPS will make every effort to accommodate with alternative options. Please email <u>Ask.Dietitian@mpls.k12.mn.us</u> for more information.

My food box is different from the menu I saw on the website or in the video. Why?

Exact items in the food box may vary depending on the availability of items. Sometimes supply, food delivery, or other issues result in last minute substitutions. Thank you for your understanding.
