Timeline	Action Items
April 15	<p>The Office of Indian Education informs schools of their American Indian Parent Advisory Committee requirements.</p> <p>The Office of Indian Education informs school districts of their Indian Education Aid estimate (for those with 20 or more students).</p>
April - June	<p>School districts and charters new to AIPAC begin planning and outreach to American Indian students, families, staff, and community members.</p> <p>If eligible, districts begin Indian Education Aid Application planning in collaboration with AIPAC.</p>
September	<p style="text-align: center;">Schedule Fall AIPAC meetings.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Conduct comprehensive outreach for AIPAC participation.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Collaborate with AIPAC on Indian Education Program and/or Indian Education Aid Application.</p>
October 1	<p><u>Indian Education Aid Applications deadline (if eligible) to submit to the Office of Indian Education, submit to mde.indian-education@state.mn.us.</u></p>
October - December	<p style="text-align: center;">Continue with AIPAC meetings to support Indian Education program and American Indian student engagement needs.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Begin discussion with AIPAC focused on data and other needs for the Annual Concurrence/Nonconcurrence vote. Employ the Indian Education Self-Assessment Rubric.</p>
January - February	<p style="text-align: center;">Schedule meetings focused on Annual Concurrence-Nonconcurrence Vote.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Vote on annual Concurrence/Nonconcurrence.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Present resolution and accompanying letter to school board.</p>
March 1	<p><u>Annual Concurrence/Nonconcurrence paperwork due to the Office of Indian Education, submit to mde.indian-education@state.mn.us.</u></p>
